What is it about?

The Individual with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) mandates nondiscriminatory assessment practices for children of culturally and linguistically diverse (CLD) backgrounds. This becomes particularly important when working with students that are identified as English Language Learners (ELLs). This workshop will review the relevant elements and methods involved in assessing these unique populations from a Cross Battery/Cattell Horn Carroll (CHC)/Pattern Strengths and Weaknesses (PSW) perspective. This assessment framework will be presented as a sequenced three-phased approach that will guide the assessor through the assessment process with consideration of contextual factors.
